We closed our nursing home on the 5th march and from that time one we provided us with all protective equipment we could get. At the moment we have enough PPE but I don't know how long.

We get the necessary equipment form the hospital, but we also have installed a Tasc Forse for the nurcing home, which is collaborating with the sanitary Tasc force.

We isolate them in their rooms, if we have more we would create an isolation station. In our nursing home we have isolated all clients and serve all in the rooms. We provided us with tablets to enable our clients to call their parents via Whatsapp or skype.

We have installed an intern management regime (Director, Doctor, Nursing Director and Housekeeping Director) to coordinate all measures.
